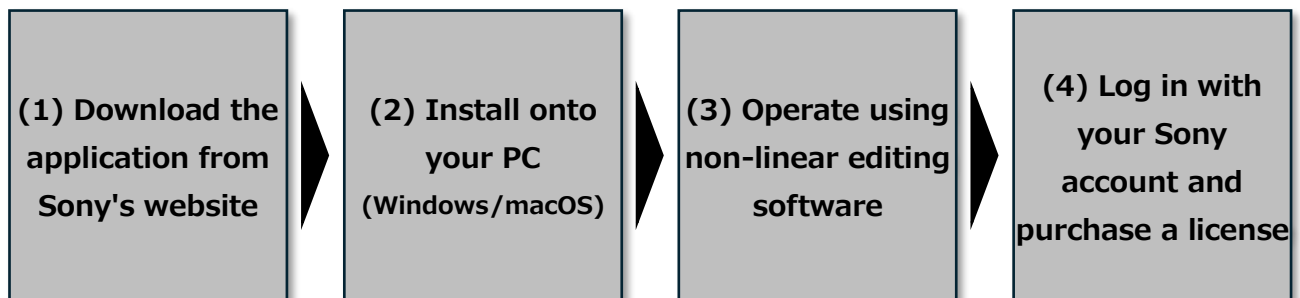
Quick Start Guide

■ Introduction

Catalyst Prepare Plugin for Adobe Premiere Pro is a powerful image correction tool that enables the use of image correction functions such as Lens Compensation and image stabilization, as well as the Color Adjustment function found in Catalyst Prepare, directly on Adobe Premiere Pro. This guide explains the steps for use, from preparation to correction operations.

■ Steps Before Usage

You can easily start using the plugin in 4 steps. First, you can test it for free, and then use it without restrictions through a paid subscription.



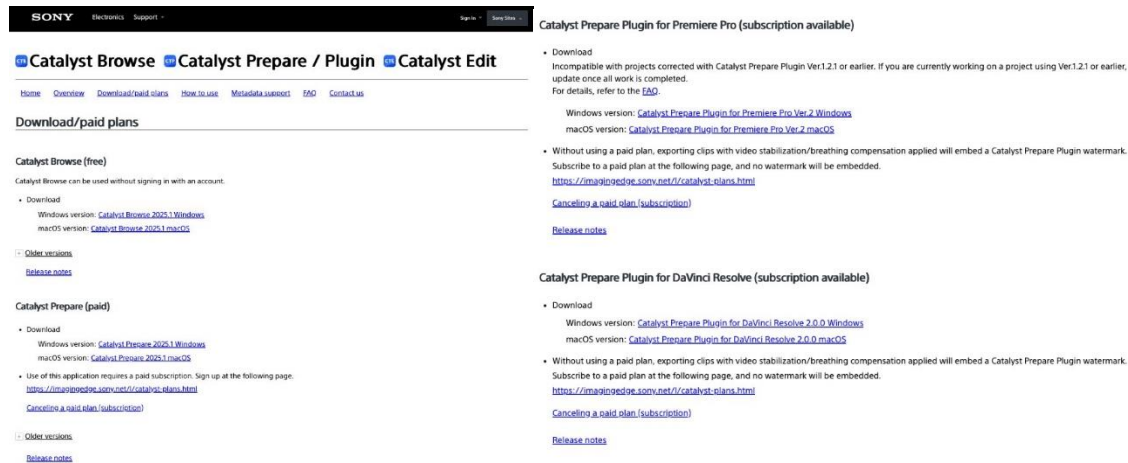

① Download Application

Access the Sony homepage and download the app according to the OS you are using. Check your PC system requirements as well.

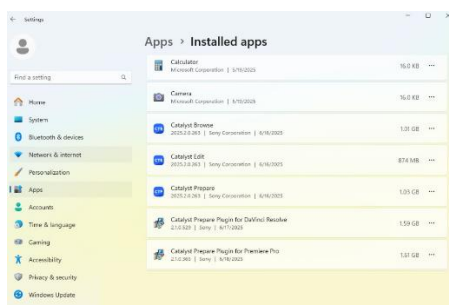

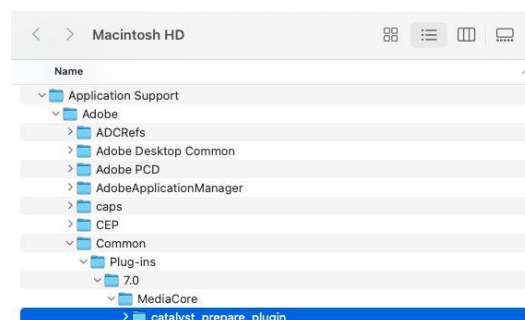
② Install onto your PC (Windows/macOS)

Use the installer to run the installation. Follow the steps provided by the installer. After completion, confirm that the application is installed on your PC.

- For Windows: Check the list via "Apps" → "Installed apps".
- For macOS: you can check in "Library > Application Support > Adobe > Common > Plug-ins > 7.0 > MediaCore".

For macOS, check via macOS Finder

③ Operate using non-linear editing software

Finally, we will now begin the actual adjustments process. The functions of this plugin can be used with video clips shot with Sony cameras. Be sure to import the filmed clips into the project of your non-linear editing software beforehand.

For the first use, ensure that your PC is connected to the internet. In addition, make sure to conduct a functionality test using a test project before applying it to your main editing project.

Note that the screen image descriptions that follow may vary in positioning based on individual user display settings.

If an error has occurred during the process, refer to the FAQ for troubleshooting.

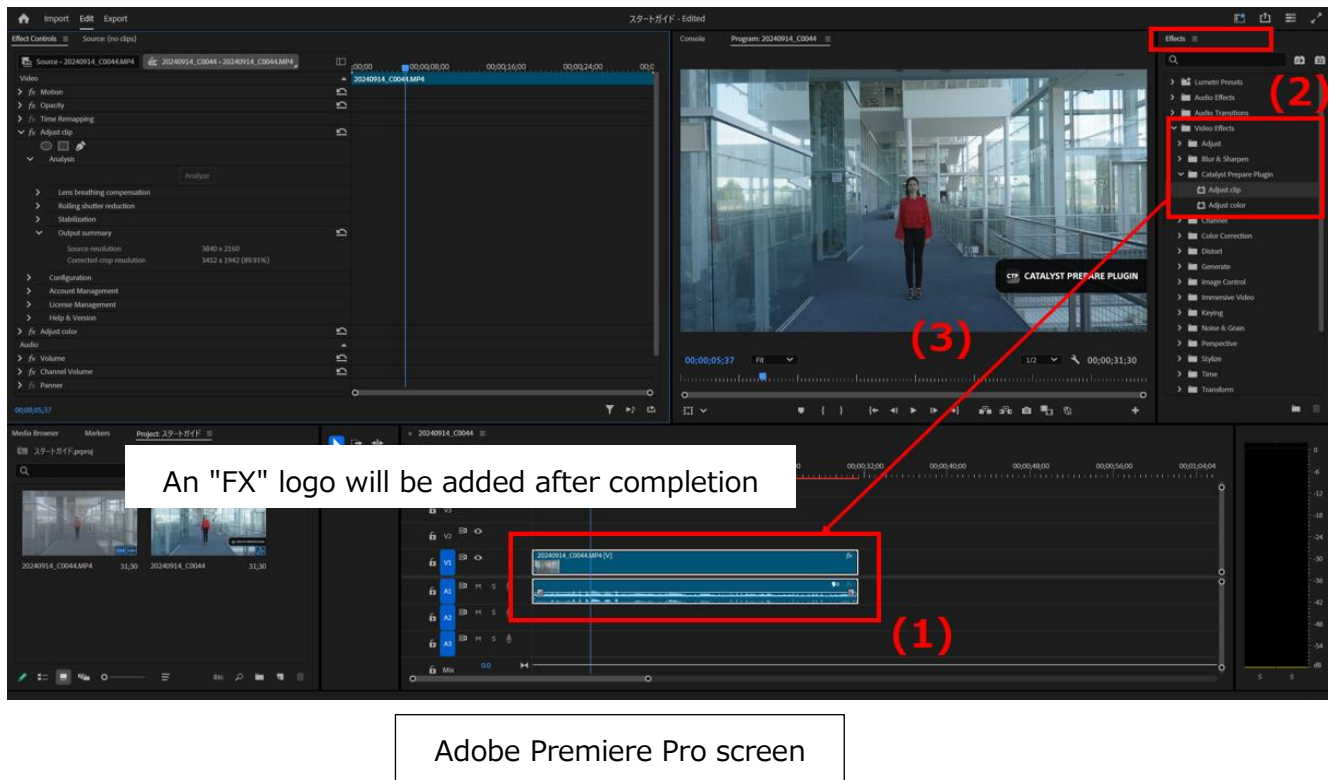

3-1. Applying Effects to Clips on the Timeline

First, apply the Catalyst Prepare Plugin effects to the clips.

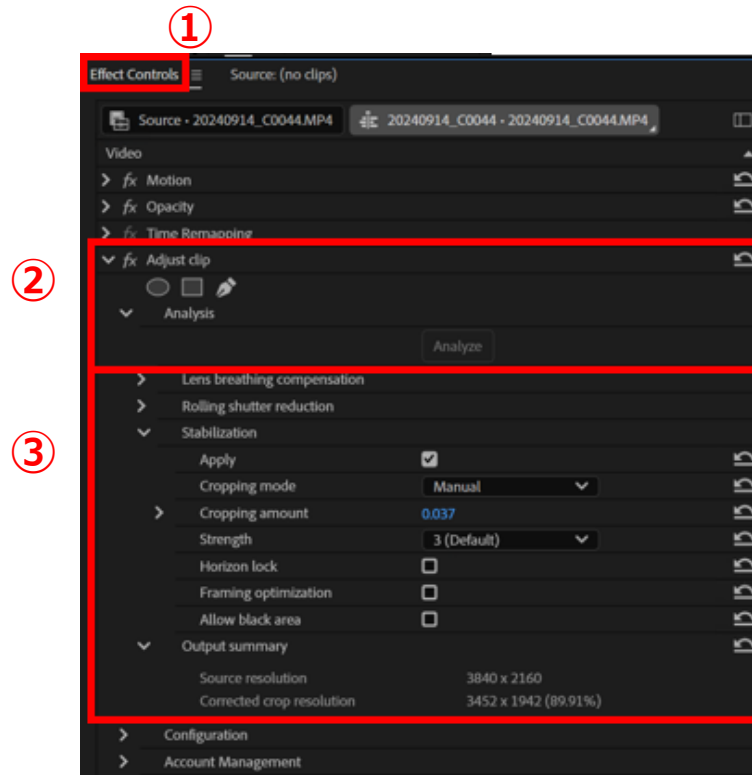
1. Arrange the clips shot with your Sony camera on the Timeline.
2. Select "Catalyst Prepare Plugin" from "Video Effects" under the "Effects" tab.
3. The following plugins are available:
 - Adjust Clip: Allows for stabilization and other video adjustments.
 - Adjust Color: Apply embedded LUTs and adjust the exposure within the clip.
4. Drag and drop the desired plugin menu onto the clip on the Timeline. An "FX" logo will be added to the upper right corner of the clip.



3-2. Adjusting Effects

Adjust the effects on the clip to which the plugin has been applied, then apply the effect. The Catalyst Prepare Plugin is characterized by its fast correction processing. The high-speed correction processing allows for smooth changes to the setting values. Experience a high degree of freedom in refining the video to your liking.

1. With the clip you want to adjust selected, select "Effect Controls" to display the Catalyst Prepare Plugin adjustment screen.
2. Select the item you want to correct and press "Analyze". Once the analysis is complete, the correction effect will be applied.
3. You can adjust the correction values for the functions you are using. Depending on the function, a re-analysis may be required.
4. In such cases, press "Analyze" again in step 2.

Adjust Clip	Lens breathing compensation	Corrects the phenomenon where the angle of view or focal length of a lens changes when the focus is adjusted.
	Lens distortion compensation	Corrects lens distortions introduced during shooting (X-OCN format only)
	Rolling shutter reduction	Corrects and reduces rolling shutter distortions caused by camera movements.
	Stabilization	Corrects the shake (camera shake) that occurs during handheld shooting, reducing the shakiness in the footage. In this version, we have newly added a function to adjust the intensity of the stabilization and a framing optimization function.
	Horizon lock	Corrects tilted images to keep them level.

Adjust Color	Adjust color	<p>Apply embedded LUTs and adjust the exposure within the clip.</p> <p>The following can be selected in EI mode.</p> <p>Metadata: The exposure metadata is automatically applied based on the camera settings.</p> <p>Manual: Manually set the exposure. The exposure of the entire clip can be adjusted.</p> <p>Off: Turn off exposure adjustments. The original sensitivity will be applied as is.</p>

④ Log in with your Sony account and purchase a license

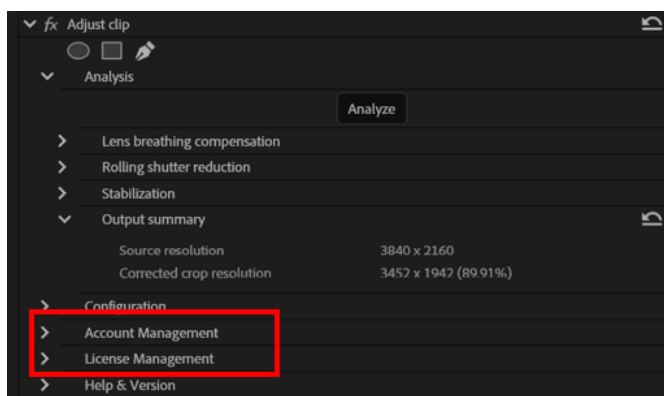
Were you able to successfully correct your clips? We hope you experienced high-speed, high-precision correction processing.

Please consider purchasing a license to use the full functionality. You can access the license purchase site from the plugin while connected to the network.

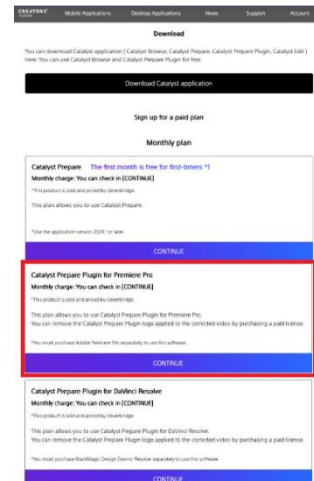

■ Important notice for users of versions V1.2.1 and earlier who are upgrading to V2.0.1 and later:

There is no compatibility between Plugins V2.0.1 and later and V1.2.1. We recommend creating a new project to use Plugins V2.0.1 and later.

To apply Plugins V2.0.1 and later to projects that included Plugins V1.2.1 and earlier, you can use any of the following methods:

- Exclude the clips from the project, re-import them, and then apply the Plugins V2.0.1 and later.
- Keep the project clips as they are and newly apply the Plugins V2.0.1 and later. (In this case, the Plugin settings items applied in V1.2.1 will be displayed in the source effect panel, but this will not affect the new Plugin effects.)
